

Privacy notice on recordings by video surveillance

"Rex Cultura" Vendéglátó és Kereskedelmi Korlátolt Felelősségű Társaság (seat: 8000 Székesfehérvár, Mátyás király krt. 1., company registration number: 07-09-006049; „**Company**”) for complying with the Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council („**Regulation**”) informs you in this privacy notice on the processing of your image recorded by video surveillance:

1 The controller and the data protection officer

The controller in respect of your personal data is "Rex Cultura" Vendéglátó és Kereskedelmi Korlátolt Felelősségű Társaság (seat: 8000 Székesfehérvár, Mátyás király krt. 1., company registration number: 07-09-006049).

The Company has not appointed a data protection officer.

2 The purpose and legal basis for processing

The Company processes your image for the protection of its movable and immovable property and for the protection of physical integrity and life.

The legal basis for the processing is the legitimate interest of the Company (Article 6 Section (1) Point f) Regulation). The legitimate interest of the Company is to protect its movable and immovable property and to investigate the circumstances of illegal activities on its territory and use the recordings of illegal activities as evidence.

3 Persons entitled to access the personal data and review the recordings

The Company is constantly viewing the recordings of the video surveillance. The managing director of the Company and the receptionist are entitled to view the recordings of the video surveillance, the managing director, the receptionist and the system administrators, Székesfehérvári Egyházmegye (seat: 8000 Székesfehérvár, Városház tér 5.) and "ABG-NET" Kereskedelmi és Szolgáltató Korlátolt Felelősségű Társaság (seat: 8000 Székesfehérvár, Mártírok útja 5; company registration number: 07-09-011866), are entitled to review the recordings of the video surveillance.

Based on the instruction of the managing director of the Company, the recordings may be reviewed in the below cases:

- to investigate the circumstances of the Company's damage to movable and immovable property,
- suspected preparation of a crime against the Company's property,
- suspected infringement of the Company's movable or immovable property,
- accidents and personal injuries occurring on the Company's territory,
- suspicion of illegal acts in the Company's territory,
- to investigate the circumstances of illegal acts that have taken place in the territory of the Company.

4 Recipients of personal data

The Company gives access to your image recorded by video surveillance to Székesfehérvári Egyházmegye (seat: 8000 Székesfehérvár, Városház tér 5.) and "ABG-NET" Kereskedelmi és Szolgáltató Korlátolt Felelősségű Társaság (seat: 8000 Székesfehérvár, Mártírok útja 5; company registration number: 07-09-011866).

5 Retention period of the personal data

The Company processes the recordings for 5 (five) days.

6 Data subjects' rights

To exercise your rights related to data processing, you may contact the Company at the email address adatvedelem@szentgellerthotel.hu.

The Company shall comply with the request of the data subject on exercising his rights within a maximum of one month from the receipt thereof. The date of receipt of the application does not count for the calculation of the deadline.

If necessary, taking into account the complexity of the application and the number of requests, the Company may extend this deadline by another two months. The Company will notify you of the extension of the deadline, stating the reasons for the delay, within one month of receiving the request.

You may exercise the below right with the Company:

6.1. Right to access

You may request information from the Company as to whether the Company processes your personal data.

When submitting the request, please indicate the place where the recording was made and the time interval for making the recording to the nearest 30 minutes.

If your request includes the handing over of a copy, the Company will provide you with a copy of the processed personal data in such a way that no other recorded persons will be identifiable on the copy of the recording.

6.2. Right to rectification

You have the right to request the Company to rectify your inaccurate personal data or supplement your incomplete personal data without undue delay.

Your right to rectification does not extend to the Company modifying the camera image, however, it does extend to the Company rectifying the record on the review of the camera recording or the issuance of the camera image if it contains inaccurate or incomplete personal data.

6.3. Right to erasure and right to object

You may request the erasure of the image or object to the data processing.

The Company will not erase the recording if the interest balance test performed concerning the video surveillance confirms that the Company has a priority legitimate interest as opposed to the rights of the data subject and informs you about the contents of the interest balance test; or if the processing of personal data is necessary for the fulfillment of a legal obligation applicable to the Company requiring the processing of personal data or if it is necessary for the submission, enforcement or protection of legal claims.

The Company erases the recording if you object to the data processing and the Company has no priority legitimate interest for the data processing, or if it is obliged to erase the personal data in order to fulfill its legal obligation.

6.4. Right to restriction of the data processing

You may request a restriction of the processing of personal data if you dispute the accuracy of the personal data, the processing is illegal and you object to the deletion of personal data, the Company does not need the personal data for processing purposes, but you require the

restriction of the personal data for the submission, enforcement or protection of legal claims or you object to the processing for reasons related to your own situation.

7 Possible steps in case of infringement

- 7.1. If you believe that the Company has violated your rights during the processing of your personal data, you may contact the Company at the email address adatvedelem@szentgellerthotel.hu.
- 7.2. In case of violation of your rights relating to your personal data, you lodge file a complaint with the National Data Protection and Freedom of Information Authority (email address: ugyfelszolgalat@naih.hu, mailing address: 1363 Budapest, Pf. 9., address: 1055 Budapest, Falk Miksa utca 9-11., phone: +36 (1) 391-1400, website address: naih.hu).
- 7.3. In case of violation of your rights relating to your personal data, you have the opportunity to go to court to protect your data, which will act in expedited procedure. In this case, you are free to decide whether to bring an action before the regional court having jurisdiction over your place of residence (permanent address) or place of residence (temporary address) or the registered seat of the Company.
